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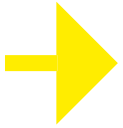

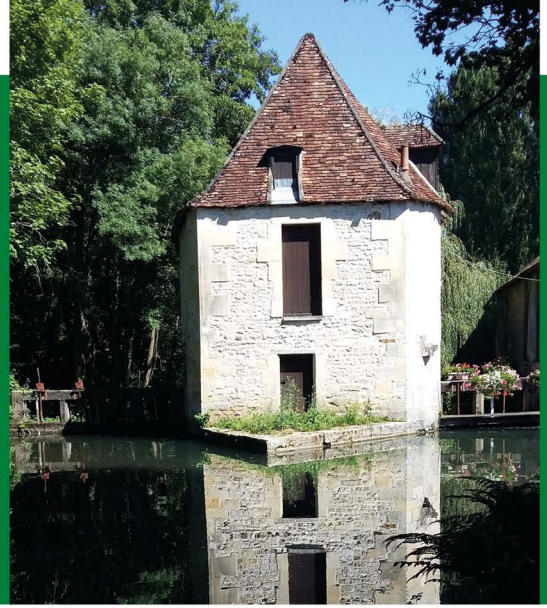

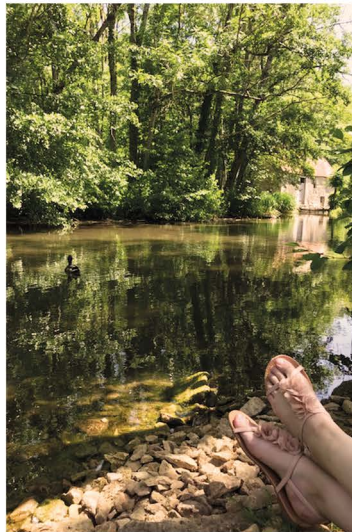

## CULTURAL LIFE with the Loire Museum

Take an inspiring cultural break in the centre of town, by visiting the small museum which houses some of the great names from the Ecole de Paris. A unique opportunity to stand alone in front of a Chagall or to find out more about the life of Loire mariners.



**Only two hours from Paris**, Cosne is perfectly situated for a **long weekend**, being at the crossroads of the vineyards of Sancerre, Pouilly and the Coteaux du Giennois, the château de Guédelon, the Donziais forests, the canal bridge at Briare and the UNESCO site at La Charité-sur-Loire.

Everything to make your **stay successful** is within easy reach; restaurants **for all tastes**, hotels, bed and breakfasts, large country cottages to accommodate your family, small gites **to recharge your batteries** for a couple of nights before continuing your trip along the cycle route 'La Loire à Vélo', campsites for **open-air living**, and also all the essentials for your **holiday purchases!**



## Bistros, markets, bric-a-brac... THE ART OF LIVING!

Board your train at Bercy station, relax in your compartment, get off at Cosne-Cours-sur-Loire, take a few steps and...

- Go into Papy Moustache de Montmartre, a bric-a-brac shop resembling Ali Baba's cave.
- Then continue your walk to Gambetta Square, where you can sit on a shady terrasse and try the local wines.
- Cross the bridge for lunch by the side of the Loire, in an open-air style café with a panoramic view over the town.

### Other bric-a-bracs?

In the town centre there's the more traditional "Souvenirs d'Antan" and the new, creative "Château Bohème".

For an open-air bric-a-brac once a month you'll find Belle Broc by the side of the Loire.

### Other bars and bistros?

Explore the Boulevard de la République and you will be spoilt for choice!

If you'd like to sip a drink while admiring a wonderful view why not try the Terrasses de l'Île, and don't miss the rooftops of the M.

## THE ZIG ZAG WALK

The charming village of Cessy-les-Bois marks the starting point of a walk for all the family towards the bat colonies present in the Natura 2000 zone; the little horseshoe bat and Geoffroy's bat are a great source of pride locally.

*Continue straight on towards “la croix du pain tortillé”, the cross that young newly-weds passed to bring them good luck. Then you arrive in front of a circle planted with vines, a little further on you’ll find the bell tower of Pouilly and a beautiful view over the vineyard.*

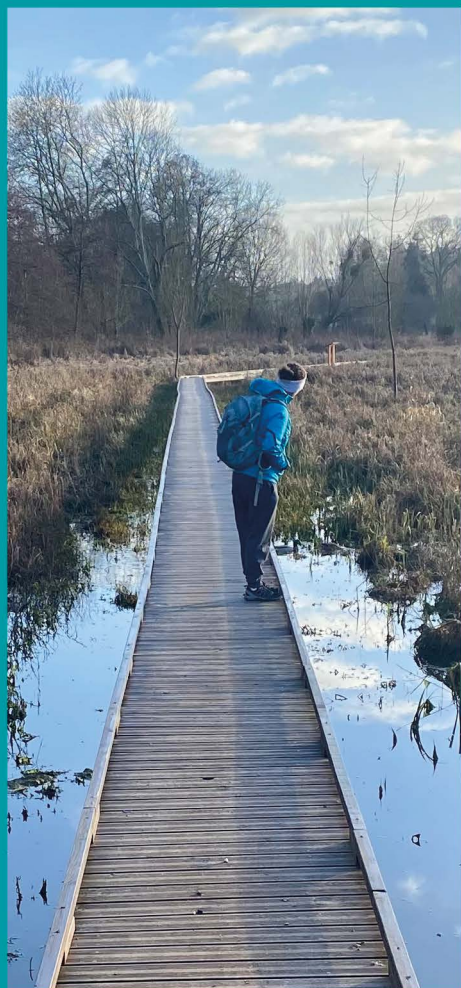

## 5 IDEAS FOR BREAKS BY BIKE

3. Set off on the **Eurovélo 6** in the direction of the Black Sea to eventually stop and meditate in the **cloisters of the Notre Dame Priory** at La **Charité sur Loire**.

5. Follow the itinerary of the **migrating birds** which fly north and rest by the biggest rose garden in Burgundy at **Neuvy sur Loire**.

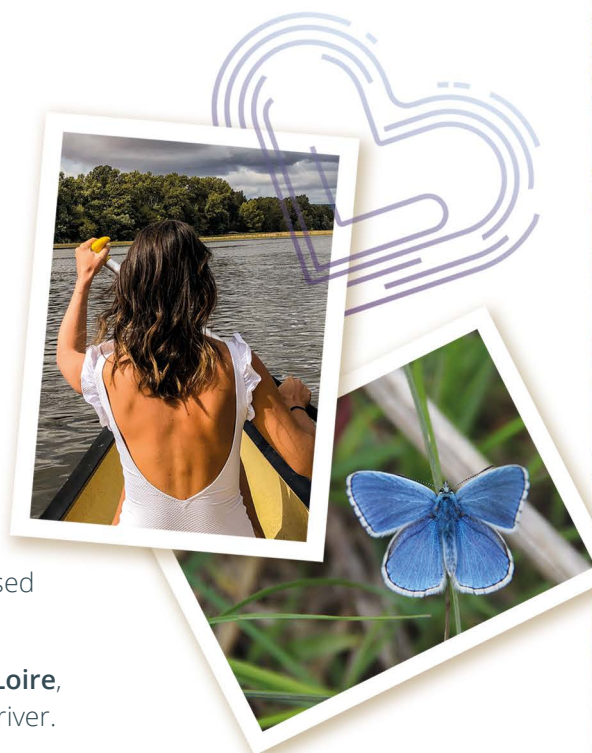

# 5 STEPS to experience the vineyards and the wines at La Tour du Pouilly Fumé

In the heart of the village, visit La Tour du Pouilly Fumé which, with a sensory scenography helps you to better understand the vines, the work of the wine growers and the wines of Pouilly.

**LISTEN** ~ Because behind every wine there are men who develop them, we suggest you sit around a big table in the cellar and listen to the winegrowers of Pouilly tell the eventful story of their more than thousand-year-old vineyard.

**FEEL** ~ Admire the hillsides throughout the seasons and the continually changing scenery; follow the wine growers from the Saint Vincent to the grape harvest. Feel the coolness of the winter mists or the heat of the summer; watch the vine stock develop, smell the wet earth after a storm.

**SHARE** ~ Discover the mystery of vinification from the arrival of the grapes in the wine cellar through to the bottling. Listen to the wine growers speak with passion revealing a few of their secrets.

**SMELL** ~ In a cellar full of history, discover the aromatic families of the white wines of Pouilly. In each retort the aromas come only from natural products. A magical moment



**TASTE** ~ At the end of the visit take advantage of a guided wine tasting of four wines which will enable you to put into practice your new skills. The selected wines will help you understand the difference between Pouilly-sur-Loire and Pouilly Fumé and the influence of the terroir on the aromas and the taste.

## AOC Coteaux du Giennois

200 hectares • 3 grape varieties: sauvignon, pinot noir and gamay • 1 AOC Coteaux du Giennois • White, red, and rosé wines

### Need a surprise?

Leave the travelled routes and come and meet the wine growers of the **Coteaux du Giennois**. Small in size but big in wine quality, the appellation offers wines with a surprising “pleasure for money”!



### Viewpoint from the village of Saint Père

From this large, unpretentious, panoramic viewpoint you can admire the town of Cosne-Cours-sur-Loire, the neighbouring appellations, the Sancerre hilltop, Saint-Andelain hill, and don't forget the Loire, the link between these three appellations.



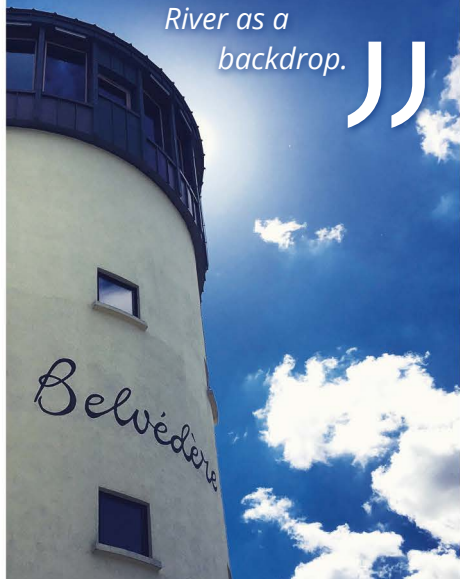
### How to get here 47°24'46.7"N 2°58'04.8"E

Park in front of the church.

Go around the church on the left, then go up la rue des vignes on your left. This is also the starting point for a 9-kilometer walk through the vineyards.

To take advantage of this exceptional panorama all year round, climb to the top of the belvedere of Saint-Andelain.

## AOC Pouilly Fumé & Pouilly sur Loire

1 400 hectares • 2 grape varieties: sauvignon and chasselas  
• 2 AOC: Pouilly Fumé & Pouilly sur Loire • Dry white wines

White wine lovers **all over the world** can recognise the essential **Pouilly Fumé**.

Rarer but appreciated for its freshness and not to be missed is the **Pouilly sur Loire**.



### Viewpoint from the wine growing village Les Loges

From the top of Les Loges the panorama over the Loire and its islands, the vineyards of Pouilly and Sancerre hilltop is breath-taking.



### How to get there 47°18'26.0"N 2°55'15.8"E

The adventurous can get there via the Milieu de Loire Footpaths which go through the vineyards to reach Les Loges. When you arrive at 'la croix des pains tortillés' take the time to turn around, you won't regret it!

# AOC Sancerre

3 000 hectares • 2 grape varieties: sauvignon and pinot noir • 1 AOC Sancerre • White, red and rosé wines

On the left bank of the Loire, the villages give their names to two famous AOC wines: **Sancerre** and **Chavignol**. Hidden behind the celebrated Sancerre are the picturesque little streets and enchanting banks of the river Loire.



## Viewpoint from the Ménétréol-sous-Sancerre viaduct

Certainly one of the prettiest photo spots in the Sancerre vineyards and the Loire area, to make the most of it we suggest you walk along the viaduct and play with the perspectives!



## How to get there 47°19'02.0"N 2°51'12.2"E

The simplest way is to park alongside the Canal Latéral à la Loire and to walk down the little streets which will take you from the village centre to the viaduct.



# IGP Côte de la Charité

50 hectares • 3 grape varieties: sauvignon, chardonnay, pinot noir • 1 AOC Côte de La Charité • White, red, rosé and gris wines  
• Still and sparkling

Although not far from the Loire, as are the neighbouring vineyards, the climate, the geographical relief, and the soil gives this vineyard a Burgundian tone.

A very old vineyard, whose recent recognition is due to passionate young wine growers. It's worth a detour!



## Viewpoint from the village of Saint-Lay

To take advantage of the most beautiful viewpoint in the vineyards of the Côtes de la Charité, you need to leave the historic centre of La Charité-sur-Loire, walk alongside the Forêt de Bertranges towards Clamecy as far as the village of Saint-Lay.

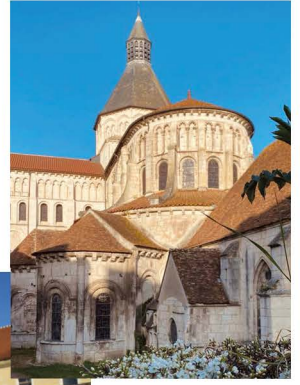
